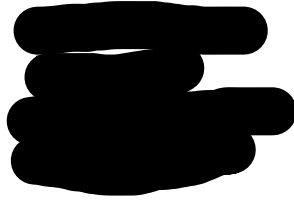

To Whom it May Concern:

I have a timely claim in the above referenced case. In an effort to help as many actual victims as possible I have forgone the use of legal representation and am Pro Se. We victims are being raped enough by exorbitant legal fees and I'm putting my faith in God to convict hearts to do the right thing.

As per Judge Drain's repeated instructions that nothing precludes non-mediated negotiations between the Debtors and other "Parties of Interest", I am reaching out to you all to see if some type of settlement can be reached because I have the desire to help others, not just myself.

I have over fifteen years of receipts for all the opiates I've taken since 2002. I was prescribed every drug I took and I've NEVER been in trouble with the law. My "lived experience" is much different than many of the stories this plan seems to try and solve. This plan seems to actually neglect those of us who took opiates under a doctor's care for a legitimate condition! It is hyper-focused, in my opinion, on solving the "illegal drug use" problem by victimizing the victims of prescription opiate use!

There are some benefits, such as helping NAS children but only those who happen to live in areas receiving funds will benefit. Rural areas are typically neglected and underserved and many have been destroyed by the side-effects of generational drug use. While I want to put resources towards solving the illegal use of drugs, because it affects all of us, the instigators of the opiate crisis are your clients. They are culpable for starting this crisis and allowing it to continue once it was evident there was a problem. They are certainly culpable for my own damages. I didn't end up in jail. My chains were

Instead, it traps people by putting them on chemicals they have great difficulty getting off of. I was only able to stay out of the criminal justice system because of my "lived experience" prior to being placed on opiates and God provided for me.

Without the changes made to Pain Management in order to increase profits by Purdue Pharma, the CDC, FDA, and others, I never would have been prescribed the massive number of opiates during the formative years of my children's lives. I didn't share all of their trauma on the "public docket" because of obvious reasons and they still refuse to talk about it! They were just elementary school children when their nightmare began.

I would like to add that developmental delay, special needs and many of the problems that NAS children will struggle with can be treated with lots of therapy and parent/caregiver training. My whole house was labeled for my son, diagnosed with Severe Apraxia of Speech, and I observed his therapy and incorporated those strategies into his childhood! I gave him a running narrative of everything we did until I became an over-medicated mess. By then he needed different help and I was only partially available to him, sometimes not at all. He has done well though and I give God all the glory! Without family support and faith in God, my children would have suffered even more due to these drugs. He speaks perfectly now. NAS children will have similar issues and due to my experience, I have great empathy for them. Without intervention, they are at huge risk of future problems.

I am very familiar with the monumental task of obtaining appropriate services in rural America. My corner of Arkansas was and still is a black hole of services for children with special needs and just about everything else. I hope to correct that by designating much of my damages toward helping others.

If I were to settle my claim, I would also want a large portion would go towards supplementing the RSAT program being operated through my county jail and supported by local churches. I've never been in trouble for anything so I don't have any "lived experience" with the criminal justice system, but I want to help those people. I could have easily ended up there without Jesus Christ protecting me. My "lived experience" is strictly through the Medical Industrial Complex side of drug use, of which Purdue Pharma plays a big role. They could not have sold me so many pain medications without the cooperation of the FDA, CDC and thousands of healthcare providers. Without the complicit collaboration by the aforementioned groups, I never would have been prescribed the massive quantity of drugs I consumed. I would like to sue them all but I've chosen to put my energy towards sharing God's Grace.

I am giving license to myself to risk the paltry sum this bankruptcy case might offer me in order to help my fellow man. I know I'm Blessed to have my life preserved and my Purpose in life is to share the Grace I've received. I believe that it's important to treat people where they live and I would direct the funds for maximum impact in my community so I have options as I age and to help others who suffer, especially now that the Medical Industrial Complex has decided to abuse pain patients by relegating them to criminal status. We are not all the same but we suffer many of the same long-term side-effects of drug use.
